

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS CHANGING THE JOB TITLE OF COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICER (CSO) TO VILLAGE SERVICE ATTENDANT (VSA)

WHEREAS, The Village of Dixmoor has employed Community Service Officers in the past who were unsworn and under the direction of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, in order to more effectively define job activities and assist the needs of the Village, the Village President and Village Board of Trustees (hereinafter "Corporate Authorities") feel as if it is in the Village's best interest to change the job title from Community Service Officer (hereinafter "CSO") to Village Service Attendant (hereinafter "VSA") and to have the VSA's supervised by the Mayor's office.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTTES OF THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1 That the job title of Community Service Officer be changed to Village Service Attendant and that the VSA's be supervised by the Mayor's Office.

Section 2. This resolution shall be in effect upon its passage approval and publication according to law.

Section 1. Section 2. That any and all money of sums of money appropriated here and not heretofore expended and now in the possession of the Treasury of the Village, and such sums of money as may hereafter come into possession of the Treasury of the Village is now appropriated for the payment of any and all contingent expenses by this Ordinance.

Section 3. That any balance of money not unexpected and on hand in any of the appropriations and item herein above described may be used for the payment of any lawful corporate debt or charge heretofore incurred by the Village.

Section 4. That any appropriations herein for salaries, wages or other related expenses shall be regarded as a maximum appropriation No employee, officer or agent shall have the right to demand continuous employment and compensation by reason for any appropriation if it becomes necessary to discharge, eliminate or reduce the number of hours worked for a position or employee on account of lack of work or fund. In the case of any vacancy in any office or position herein, the vacancy shall not be required to be filled and there shall exist no necessity thereof, if it is in the best judgment and sole discretion of the Village President and Board of Trustees.

Section 5. Any appropriation herein for any liability, judgment, claim, unpaid bill or debt shall not be construed as an approval of any such liabilities or unpaid bills, but shall be regarded only as an appropriation for the payment thereof, when and if they are found to be valid and legal obligations against the Village.

Section 6. That if any section, subdivision, sentence or line item of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or provisions of the Ordinance.

Section 7. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 8. That a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Clerk of the County of Cook, State of Illinois, by the Village Clerk within 30 days after its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ATTACHED "APPLICATION FOR ZONING VARIANCE AND SPECIAL USE PERMIT" AS THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR OFFICIAL APPLICATION FOR ZONING VARIANCE OR SPECIAL USE PERMIT REQUESTS and AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR FEE SCHEDULE TO INCLUDE THE APPLICATION FOR ZONING VARIANCE OR SPECIAL USE PERMIT FEES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

- **Sec. 1.** The attached application titled "VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR, ILLINOIS APPLICATION FOR ZONING VARIANCE or SPECIAL USE PERMIT" shall serve as the Village's official application for any and all zoning variance or special use permit requests (hereinafter "Application").
- **Sec. 2**. The Application shall include a fee to applicants, with the following fee schedule:

For Special Use Permits-\$150.00 For Variance to Industrial Zone and Commercial Zone-\$500.00 For Variance to Residential Zone-\$350.00

Sec. 3. The Village of Dixmoor Fee Schedule shall be amended to include the Application fee schedule.

ORDINANCE NO. 10-KO-09

VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING DANGEROUS DOGS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Village Code Amended. Chapter 6. Article II Section 6-13 of the Village Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

DANGEROUS DOG DECLARED NUISANCE

No person shall own, keep or harbor a dangerous dog within the village, unless such person shall keep same confined safely and in a secure enclosure so as to protect from injury any person who shall come upon the premises where such dog or other animal is located. All owners and persons maintaining the premises upon which such dog or other animal is confined shall provide suitable and adequate warning of the presence of such dangerous dog by appropriate signs, visible from the front sidewalk, that are weather-proof durable and $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ minimum in size to advise all persons lawfully entering upon such premises that a dangerous dog is confined thereon. Any such dog within the village whose owner is in violation of the foregoing shall be deemed and held to be a public nuisance. The owner, keeper, or possessor of a dangerous dog in violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$1,000. Upon the entry of a court order regarding a second conviction for the same offense, the Animal Control Warden may cause the dangerous dog to be impounded at the owner's expense.

- **Section 2**. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.
- **Section 3**. Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **Section 4**. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication provided by law.
