### ORDINANCE NO. 13-10-65

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE III, BOARD OF TRUSTEES, DIVISION 2, MEETINGS OF THE DIXMOOR CODE OF ORDINANCES ADOPTING RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR ELECTRONIC ATTENDANCE AND PARTICIPATION AT MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois is a duly organized and validly existing non-home rule municipal corporation created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.02 of the Illinois Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/1.02), defines a "meeting" to mean "any gathering, whether in person or by video or audio conference, telephone call, electronic means (such as, without limitation, electronic mail, electronic chat and instant messaging), or other means of contemporaneous interactive communication, of a majority of a quorum of the members of a public body held for the purpose of discussing public business," and it permits attendance of members of the public body at public meetings by a means other than physical presence; and

WHEREAS, to permit attendance by a means other than physical presence, the corporate authorities of the Village of Dixmoor must adopt rules that conform to the requirements and restrictions of the Illinois Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/7; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Dixmoor desire to permit attendance of members of the public body by means other than physical presence in compliance with the Illinois Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Dixmoor find that it is necessary that any existing ordinances, resolutions or policies be amended to conform with the term "meeting" to include electronic gatherings as defined in Section 120/1.02 of the Illinois Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 102/1.02).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

**Section 1.** Recitals. The preliminary paragraphs set forth above are incorporated herein as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Adoption of Electronic Attendance at Meetings Rules and Procedures</u>. Chapter 2, Administration, Article III, Board of Trustees, Division 2, Meetings of the Dixmoor Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto, <u>Section 2-61</u>, <u>Electronic Attendance and Participation at Meetings Rules and Procedures</u>, to read as follows:

### Section 2-61. Electronic Attendance and Participation at Meetings Rules and Procedures.

- of Dixmoor that the presence of the elected officials at all public meetings is highly desirable. The public's ability to view actions being taken by elected officials and to make meaningful input into the decision-making process will be materially impaired by the lack of direct access to elected officials in the public forum provided by meetings of the Village of Dixmoor Board of Trustees. Accordingly, the provisions for remote attendance at meetings set forth in these rules and procedures are intended to provide for the public's good, and not necessarily for the convenience or ease of the elected officials. As such, it is the intent of the Corporate Authorities that this policy should be used sparingly and in strict conformance with the provisions set forth and described herein.
- (b) Rules Statement. It is the decision of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Dixmoor that any member of the Village Board of Trustees may attend any open or closed meeting of the Village Board via electronic means (such as by telephone, video or internet connection) provided that such attendance is in compliance with these rules and procedures and any applicable laws.
- (c) <u>Prerequisites.</u> A member of the Village of Dixmoor Board of Trustees may attend a meeting electronically if the member meets the following conditions: A quorum is physically present throughout the meeting; and, a majority of the members physically present votes to approve the electronic attendance at the meeting.
  - (1) The member should notify the Village Clerk at least forty-eight (48) hours before the meeting, unless such advance notice is impractical, so that necessary communications equipment can be arranged. Inability to make the necessary technical arrangements will result in denial of a request for electronic attendance.

- (2) The member must assert one of the following three (3) reasons why he or she is unable to physically attend the meeting:
  - (I) The member cannot attend because of personal illness or disability; or
  - (ii) The member cannot attend because of employment purposes or the business of the Village of Dixmoor; or
  - (iii) The member cannot attend because of a family or other emergency.
- (3) The Village Clerk, after receiving the electronic attendance request, shall inform the Village Board of the request for electronic attendance.
- (d) <u>Voting Procedures</u>. After a roll call establishing that a quorum is physically present, the Presiding Officer shall call for a motion that a member may be permitted to attend the meeting electronically after specifying the reason entitling the absent member to attend electronically. The motion must be approved by a vote of a majority of the members physically present.
- (e) Adequate Equipment Required. The member participating electronically and all other members of the Village Board must be able to communicate effectively, and members of the audience must be able to hear all communications at the meeting site. Before allowing electronic attendance at any meeting, the Village Board shall provide equipment adequate to accomplish this objective at the meeting site.
- (f) Minutes. Any member attending electronically shall be considered an off-site attendee and counted as present electronically for that meeting. The meeting minutes shall also reflect and state specifically whether each member is physically present or present by electronic means.
- Rights of Remote Member. A member permitted to attend electronically will be able to express his or her comments during the meeting and participate in the same capacity as those members physically present, subject to all general meeting guidelines and procedures previously adopted and adhered to. The member attending electronically shall be heard, considered, and counted as to any vote taken. Accordingly, the name of any member attending electronically shall be called during any vote taken, and his or her vote counted and recorded by the Village Clerk and placed in the minutes for the corresponding meeting. A member attending electronically may leave a meeting and return as in the case of any member, provided the member attending electronically shall first announce his or her leaving and returning.
- (h) <u>Village Board Meetings</u>. These rules and procedures shall apply to all regular, special, and emergency meetings established by the authority of the Village of Dixmoor Board of Trustees.

**Section 3.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval and publication according to law.

**Section 4.** Severability. In the event that any section, clause, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be found and determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid parts shall remain in full force and effect.

## AN ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2013 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2014 OF THE VILLAGE OF DIXMOOR, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois (hereinafter, the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dixmoor, did, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2013, adopt an appropriations ordinance for the Village of Dixmoor for the fiscal year of the Village beginning on May 1, 2013, and ending on April 30, 2014, being Ordinance No. 13-DO-02, and which said ordinance was duly adopted and and timely filed with the County Clerk on July 31, 2013;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village President and the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1:** That the recitals above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**Section 2:** That taxes are hereby is levided for the fiscal year beginning on May 1, 2013, and ending on April 30, 2014, upon all property subject to taxation within the Village of Dixmoor as that property is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for said fiscal year, for the following specific purposes and funds:

**Section 3:** That the sum of \$600,660 ascertained to be collected and used for the purposes and funds hereinabove specificied be and is hereby levied and assessed on all property subject to taxation within the Village of Dixmoor, Cook County, Illinois, according according to the value of the said property as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for the current fiscal year, as provided by law.

**Section 4:** That the Village President and the Village Clerk are hereby empowered and directed to file a duly certified copy of this Ordinance and execute and file all other required documents with the office of the Cook County Clerk, Cook County, Illinois, as provided by law.

**Section 5:** That if any item or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decsion shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

**Section 6:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
